Financial Report:

The collage Concert donations totaled \$497. The budget was \$900. It is substantially less than last year's donations of \$1358.46.

The concession stand money was received in March and the total income for that line item is \$1,524.11. We had budgeted \$1,000.

The budget for upcoming events: Banquet \$1, 500; Senior awards/gifts \$175; Senior scholarships \$1,000.
