**1. Director's report**

**2. San Francisco trip update**

- Signature packet going out with kids this week. **Signatures must be witnessed and notarized.**
- Itinerary received 3/19. Mr. Mulvenon is getting clarification on a few details, but the trip includes two days in the city, and a day at the banquet/theme park near the hotel. Sunday events haven't been finalized. (Bus leaves for the airport for return trip home around 12:30.)
- Meals – Breakfast is provided each day as part of the trip. Students will need money for lunch & dinner Thursday; lunch Friday; lunch Sunday. All other meals are included in trip cost.
- Drop off for Thursday morning flight is at Terminal B at 5 a.m.
- All tickets will be printed by Mr. Mulvenon and a crew of volunteers (and given to students upon arrival at the airport).
- Since the banquet is the same day as the theme park visit, it was suggested, that students just wear orchestra shirts to the theme park, so changing (and formal clothes) will not be needed for the banquet.
